APPROVALS & POINTS

This show is approved and hosted by the Peruvian Horse Association of Canada. Qualified entries (PHAC registered horses owned by PHAC members in good standing) receive TRIPLE points toward PHAC awards in the Breeding, Gait, Pleasure and Performance Divisions. It is approved as a Regular Show by the NAPHA; qualified entries will receive points toward the Medallon de Plata and Medallon de Oro Awards in the Breeding, Gait, Pleasure Divisions and High Point Performance Horse Awards. **Please note**: Champions and Champions of Champions at this show are eligible for their respective Championship classes at the 2019 U.S. National Show.

RESPONSIBILITY

All entries are accepted with the understanding that the PHAC, NAPHA, members of the show committee and the Silver Slate Arena will not be held responsible for any loss, personal damage or injury to horses exhibited, or for any article of any kind or nature that in any way may be lost or destroyed or in any way damaged. All horses shall be under the control and direction of the Show Management but solely at the risk of the exhibitor, who will be responsible for any injury that may be occasioned to any person or animal or damage to any property while on the grounds by any horse owned or exhibited by him and shall indemnify the management against all claims or damages of any kind or nature, including attorney fees and court costs, that may arise out of any injury occasioned by any horse owned or exhibited by him or arising from any cause whatever including the negligence of himself or any other person in charge of any such horse.

PLEASE be advised that it is the participant's responsibility to ensure that they have sufficient liability insurance coverage for attending/participating at this equine event.

RULES & REGULATIONS

Everything possible is being done to conduct this show on the highest possible level for the pleasure of the exhibitors and spectators. The PHAC is most desirous of fair treatment for all exhibitors and in return ask for cooperation of all in helping to make this show a successful and enjoyable event. Both shows will be run under PHAC show rules. Every person who participates is responsible for knowledge of the PHAC rules and regulations, and is subject to the rules and regulations of:

- 1. The PHAC By-Laws
- 2. The PHAC Book of Peruvian Horse Showing 2018
- 3. The Peruvian Horse Breed Standard and PHAC Code of Ethics

Copies of any of the above can be downloaded free of charge from the PHAC website: www.phac.ca In any case where this Premium List appears to be in conflict with the PHAC rules then the above mentioned documents shall take precedence.

MEMBERSHIP & REGISTRATION REQUIREMENTS

Important Change to Entry Fees 2018 forward Non-Members of the Peruvian Horse Association of Canada are eligible to participate in this event but will be charged additional fees*. Horses registered or pending with the PHAC are eligible to be shown. Horses owned by residents of Canada MUST be registered or pending with the PHAC. Horses owned by residents of other countries are eligible to be shown provided they are registered with certificates from PHAC, AAOBPPH, PPHRNA, or NAPHA, or are pending with NAPHA. Owners in arrears with PHAC or NAPHA WILL NOT be allowed to show until arrears are cleared. *A membership application can be completed and paid for on the PHAC website prior to the show. http://www.phac.ca/forms.html

Any late exhibitors may go to the Show Office and complete a membership application and pay the membership fee. PHAC annual membership is \$45 Canadian Funds.

COMPLAINTS/PROTESTS

All complaints/protests shall be taken directly to the Show Manager. Protests must be filed in writing to the Show Manager within 48 hours of the close of the show and must be accompanied by a fee of \$100 which may be refunded if the grievance is upheld.

DRUG TESTING

Please be advised that drug testing will be done at this show. A drug testing charge has been included in each entry fee.

SUBSTITUTION OF JUDGES AND OTHER OFFICIALS

In the event that the judge (or other official designated herein) is unable to perform his/her duties due to circumstances beyond his/her control or for any other reason, the Show Committee reserves the right to substitute another approved judge (or other official) in his/her place.

JUDGES AUTHORITY

The Judge(s) shall have the authority to place any horse in whatever position in a class he/she thinks the merit of the horse justifies. The awards shall be placed on the horses as they are seen presented in the ring for each class, without regard to previous records and performances. The Judge(s) shall award prizes in order first to fifth according to merit and may not vacate places. If there are more horses of merit in a class than there are prizes offered in that class, the Judge(s) have the right to award honorable mentions. The Judge(s) may make favorable comments over the public address system about the horses shown before him/her, but shall make no negative comments. *Judges will not be permitted to ride any horse entered in this show, during the show.*

HEALTH REQUIREMENTS

Horses crossing into Canada from the United States require NEGATIVE COGGINS TEST (blood drawn within the previous six months) AND an INTERNATIONAL HEALTH CERTIFICATE endorsed by a veterinarian of the US Animal & Plant Health Inspection Service showing examination within the 30 days prior to entering Canada. This preparation can take as long as three weeks so please plan ahead. Exhibitors or their veterinarians are encouraged to call the Canadian Veterinarian at Canada Customs at the border crossing of their choice with any questions. FACILITY / STABLING

Stalls will be bedded and ready for use on Thursday August 22 by 8:00 AM.

Please let the barn manager know if you plan to arrive before then.

Each horse must have a separate stall (except broodmare with suckling foal).

All exhibitors are advised to bring snaps, buckets, hay nets, wheelbarrows and other items necessary for the care of their horses. All exhibitors shall see that their horses are maintained in a suitable manner while on the show grounds. Ample extra shavings are available as needed.

The main arena will be available for use on Thursday morning, August 22.

The warm up arena is also available in the main arena for use during the show.

An outdoor area is also available for warm-up and exercising horses.

Wash racks are available with warm water. Please clean up after your horse!!

Other facility rules:

- 1. Absolutely NO smoking in the barn area at any time
- 2. All dogs must be either tied or on a leash at all times.
- 3. Dogs are <u>not allowed</u> in concession/food area.
- 4. Owners are required to clean up after their dogs. No one likes to step in dog poop.
- 5. No outside alcohol is allowed in the arena (Silver Slate has a liquor license) (Serving alcohol in the camping area is allowed.)

CAMPING/PARKING

Camping with power and water hookup is available on the grounds at a cost of \$25/night.

There is **no charge** to tents or RV/ trailers not hooked up to power or water

SHOW OFFICE

The Show Office will be open at approximately 6:00 PM on Thursday August 22 for exhibitors to late register and pickup exhibitor packages. The show office is located in the main area beside the restaurant.

CONCESSION

The judge will be introduced to exhibitors at a meeting on Thursday evening, August 22 at 8:00 PM in the Arena.

The PHAC Annual General Meeting and 2018 High Point Awards presentation will be held in the concourse area. Sandwiches will be served complimentary of PHAC.

SHOW SAFETY

The personal safety of our participants, spectators and officials is first and foremost priority for the show committee. It is the expectation that ALL participants will come to the show prepared and ready to show their horse. We also ask that other general rules are followed while on the grounds.

- Obey 'no smoking' signs
- Keep dogs on a leash and under control and clean up after your dogs.

- No riding in the alleyways
- If at all possible, please tack and untack your horse in its stall.
- Practice show ring courtesy (maintain safe distance from other horses)
- All junior riders 12 years of age and under must wear riding helmets
- Helmets are optional for all other riders, including leadline provided there is a person leading and a person spotting the rider.

GATE RULES/ETIQUETTE

In order to stay on schedule,

- You may NOT enter at the gate. All entries must go through the show office.
- You can scratch classes at the gate, but PLEASE remember to do so either at the gate or at the show office to avoid unnecessary 3-minute gate holds.
- The 3-minute gate rule will be strictly enforced. If you have not checked in with the ring admission steward with-in that time, the gate will be closed.
- An additional **five-minute** tack change can be requested **IN ADVANCE**. Please bring sufficient tack and helpers.
- Please check in at the gate well before the start of your class so your horse number and rider information can be checked against the class entry list.

SHOW RULES

All participants at this show are responsible for a thorough knowledge of current rules and regulations. All showing procedures and judging percentages as well as definitions, class descriptions, descriptions of gear and attire, conduct and ethics and conditions for this show are available on the PHAC website:

NEW FORMAT FOR HALTER CLASSES – Trial Basis – No Running – Bring Your Young Horse For Experience, anyone can present in this format which is taken from multiple breed shows.

Alternative Halter Class Procedure:

Up to four horses shall enter the arena at one time. Each horse will enter the arena at a walk, line up and stand for conformation judging. Exhibitors will then move to an area of the arena where they have space, and the judge will move to a position where all horses can be seen. Exhibitors will lunge their horses at the Announcer's call. Horses will be asked to gait, stop, reverse, gait, stop, walk and stop again, then will be called to line up and have final judging. The Judge may call for horses to be run off by lunging, but not by the handler being required to run with the horse. *Note: Actions that may disturb other entries (such as lunging circles before the announcer calls for the movement, or when asked to line-up, or stopping intentionally) shall be forbidden and may be penalized by a lower placing or being excused. Any action that creates an unsafe situation of contact between two horses shall be grounds for dismissal.*

AWARDS & PRIZES – Large distinctive ribbons will be awarded in each class 1^{st} – 5^{th} Place, Distinctive awards for High Point Winners; Trophies will be awarded 1^{st} place, Champion and Reserve Ch, and Champion of Champions, Best Bozal, and Best Gait.

!!!!! CASH PRIZES !!!!!

We have added \$75 MYSTERY cash prizes to each qualifying class of the show. Prizes will be awarded randomly to placings 1st through 5th.

Luxury Gelding Stakes in Bit - Entry Fee \$50

To be judged as per Luxury Gelding Division rules and only open to geldings born in North America. Prize money to be awarded from a percentage of proceeds from entries and donations, to be divided as follows: 1st - 40%; 2nd - 25%; 3rd - 20%; 4th - 10%; 5th - 5%.

Mystery Cash Stakes- Breeding Mares or Stallions in Bit - Entry Fee \$20

To be judged as per Luxury/Breeding Division rules. Mystery cash prizes will be awarded.

Junior Open Attire (12& Under) - Pleasure

To be judged as a pleasure class. Entrants allowed to choose their own attire. Helmets are mandatory for junior riders in the 12 and under age category, so must be worn. Riders must wear close-toed shoes.

High Point Novice Award - Classes 9, 19, 33, 39, 49

A High Point Novice award will be presented to the novice exhibitor who has accumulated the most points in the novice classes at this show. Points will be awarded 1 - 6 in each class (1 for participation, 6 for 1st place). Juniors are NOT allowed to compete in the Novice classes. Shod horses are allowed in Novice classes.

High Point Amateur Award - Classes 31, 43, 45, 46, 48, 50

The High Point Amateur Award is open to all riders with amateur status. YOU MUST REGISTER (no charge) AT THE OFFICE IN ORDER TO COMPETE FOR THIS AWARD. High points will be calculated from the top 5 places in the above listed classes. Ties will be broken by ride-off judged on equitation & performance.

High Point and Reserve Versatility Horse Award - Classes 11, 27, 35, 41, 51

This award is being offered to promote breed versatility and encourage thorough and well-rounded training of the Peruvian Horse. Open to amateur or professional riders. Points will be awarded 1 - 6 in each class (1 for participation, 6 for 1st place). Ties will be broken, first, by the number of firsts & seconds; and if there is still a tie, then by the placing in the Trail class. Below are the 5 qualifying classes for High Point and Reserve Versatility:

In order to compete for the High Point Award, a horse must be entered in at least two of the Versatility Classes.

1. Synchronized Pairs (Bit or Bozal)

Judged as a pleasure class with maneuvers including but not limited to circles, stops, backing, figure eights and reverses. Any tack is allowed provided that a saddle and bridle is used on each horse.

2. Champagne Class (Bit or Bozal)

Maneuvers will be called for and horses **must be in gait** unless a walk has been specifically requested. A poncho or jacket is optional. Rim of glass must be visible above fingers.

Prize money will be awarded as follows: 1st Place 60%, 2nd Place 40%

3. English/Western/Australian/Plantation (Bit or Bozal)

Judged as a pleasure class. Rider's attire must match the style of tack being used on the horse.

4. Trail Class (Bit or Bozal)

Horses will be scored from 0 to 5 points for each obstacle they complete. Higher points will be awarded for confident smooth and relaxed performances. This is not a timed event and excessive speed or recklessness will be penalized. After two refusals of an obstacle, horse and rider must proceed to the next obstacle. Safety is of upmost importance. Retrancas are optional if using a Peruvian saddle. Helmets are encouraged. Pattern printed on last pages of premium list.

5. Costume (Bit or Bozal)

Anything goes but safety is important for not only the exhibitor but also fellow exhibitors.

HIGH POINT PROFESSIONAL AWARD (HPP) – TROPHY BELT BUCKLE DONATED BY PASO LLANO MAGAZINE, Kelly Powers Ponciano and Andres Ponciano

The High Point Professional Award is for professionals only – i.e. those who do not qualify for amateur status. YOU MUST REGISTER (no charge) AT THE OFFICE IN ORDER TO COMPETE FOR THIS AWARD.

Points will be calculated from best placing in one class in each division as follows:

Best placing in a Zootecnico Class from Classes 1, 2, 3

Best placing in a Halter Class from Classes 4, 6

Best placing in Breeding or Luxury Class from Classes 18, 20, 22, 24, 26, 28

Best Placing in a Bozal Class – from Classes 13, 15, 17

Best Placing in a Gait Class – from Classes 32, 36, 38, 40

Best Placing in a Performance Class - from Classes 8, 10, 12, 30

TIE will be broken by best placing in performance

CHAMPION OF CHAMPIONS CLASSES

The Champion of Champion classes are open to current year's Champions and past Champions of the Canadian National Show, as well as the Champion of Champions from any U.S. National Show. The entry fee for showing ONLY in a Champion of Champion(s) classes and not entered in any other regular classes will be \$300.00(includes stabling). The horse must complete the Prueba (Sunday) Returning Champion of Champions must submit and pay entry fees prior to the first class of the show.

PRUEBA FUNCIONAL

The Prueba Funcional will be held on Sunday August 25th, 2019 between 7:30 A.M. and 8:00 A.M. in the arena. A list of the horses that must do the Prueba will be posted outside the show office by Saturday at the close of the show. If your horse is required to do the Prueba, please report to the arena 15 minutes prior to the allotted time.

All horses entered to compete in the Champion of Champions classes in the **Pleasure or Performance Divisions** must complete the Prueba Funcional prior to the Champion of Champions Classes **UNLESS** that horse has completed at least **TWO** saddle classes. All horses entered to compete in the Champion of Champions classes in the **Breeding/Luxury Division** must complete the Prueba Funcional prior to the Champion of Champions classes **UNLESS** that horse has completed at least **TWO** of the following saddle classes:

- 1) Any GAIT CLASS
- 2) Novice Breeding/Luxury, Novice Gait
- 3) Any BREEDING / LUXURY STAKES, RANCHO/BREEDERS CONJUNTO STAKES
- 4) Any QUALIFYING CLASS for CHAMPION or RESERVE CHAMPION
- 5) Any CHAMPION and RESERVE CHAMPION Class.

SHOW ENTRIES

All entry fees include:

- Initial bedding and final cleaning of stalls. Shavings as needed throughout entire show.
- Drug test fee (\$10)

All entries must be accompanied by a copy of both the <u>front</u> and <u>back</u> of each horse's registration certificate. In the case of a "registration pending", a copy of the application for registration must be included. Horses owned by a Canadian resident must be registered or pending with the Peruvian Horse Association of Canada. Every entry form must be signed by the owner or his authorized agent. If signed by an agent, then a copy of the authorization must be included with entry.

Entry forms (with or without payment) must be received **August 16, 2019** to avoid paying **late fees** (\$25/horse)

**Pre-entry is encouraged to allow the show secretary time to review entries/ horse(s) registration and enter the data into show program. Exhibitors will not be charged for any pre-entered horse(s) unable to attend the show.




