The final amount will be determined by the PHAC board and will be based on the event requirements and the current demand for grants. The PHAC is willing to split the net cost of running the event 50/50 with the applicant. The event shall be a "not for profit" event and could be a clinic, organized trail ride, schooling show etc. It shall be held mainly to benefit the Peruvian horse, Peruvian Paso owners, and aficionados, however other gaited breeds may attend the event. A minimum of 50% of the horses attending shall be purebred Peruvian Pasos registered with the PHAC. The applicant shall be either a PHAC Affiliated club or a member in good standing with the PHAC. The applicant shall be prepared to provide an expense report, on request, to the PHAC board within three months of the event taking place. The PHAC board reserves the right to modify the grant process at their discretion.
