## Breeders' Initials Request Form

Initials Requested \_\_\_\_\_

- ◆ Breeder's initials are required to be included in the name of every horse and they will not be removed even if the name of the horse is later changed.
- ◆ Initials can be placed before the name as a prefix or after the name as a suffix. Only letters are allowed, all capitals and no punctuation.
- ◆ One set of breeders initials can be used to identify horses bred by a partnership or individuals in the partnership. I.E – if the initials are registered to Joe and Mary Smith, they can also be used for foals resulting from a mare owned just by Mary Smith.)
