

2026 Norte y Sur Peruvian Horse Championship Show Declaration of Amateur Status: Levels 1 & 2

All amateur exhibitors will be required to declare their level (1 or 2) riding status prior to the beginning of the show. As well, a signed NAPHA amateur declaration form must be completed prior to the start of show. (This form will not suffice for that requirement.)

The criteria for Level 1/Level 2 declaration are as follows:

- **Amateur Level 1:** Exhibitor/Rider that has NOT won GREATER than 10 lifetime Champion of Champion titles in ANY performance division (Amateur, Pleasure, AOTR Performance or Open Performance) in NAPHA or PHAC Approved shows.

- **Amateur Level 2:** ANY Exhibitor/Rider is allowed to ride in the Level 2 classes if they feel their skill level is more appropriate for Level 2, regardless of number of Champion of Champion titles won.

NOTE:

A Level 1 rider is allowed to ride in either Level 1 or Level 2 but cannot change levels during the show.

If a horse qualifies for the Champion/Reserve class with a Level 1 rider, only a Level 1 rider can complete competition in that division. The same rule applies if the horse qualifies for Champion of Champions. (Different level 1 riders can compete on the same horse for that division.)
